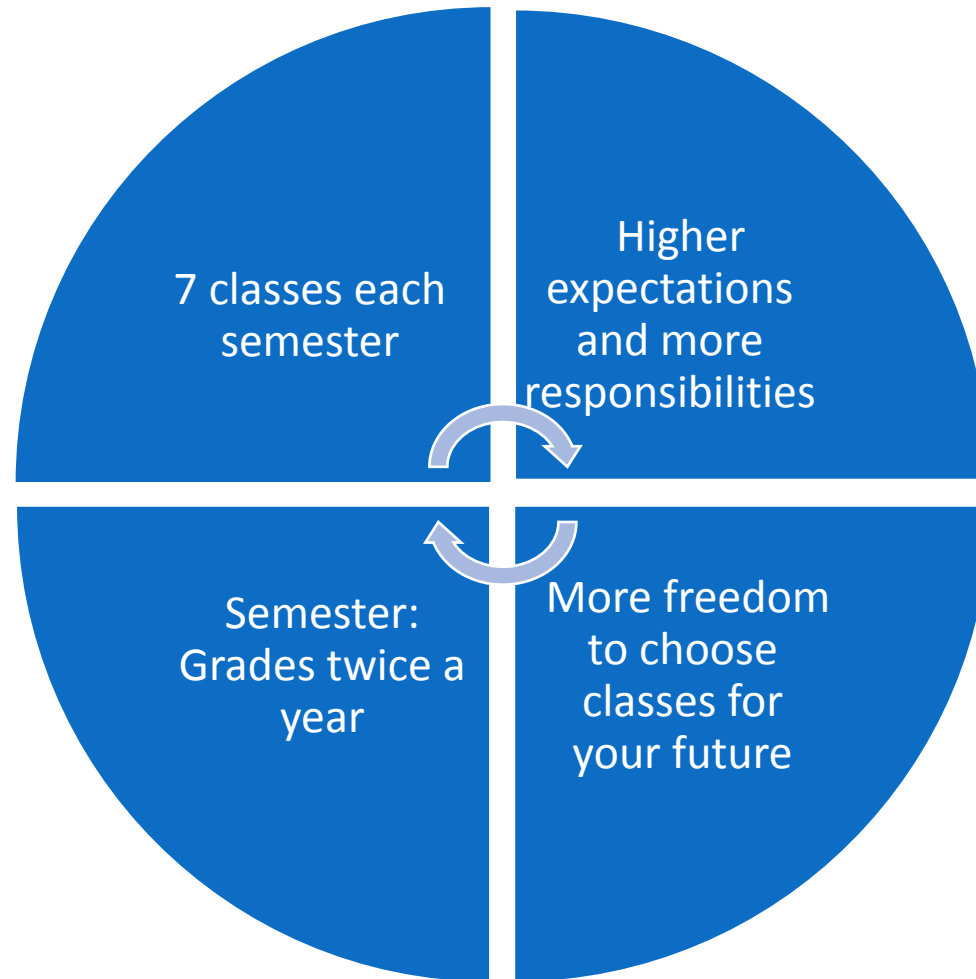

HIGH SCHOOL CREDITS TAKEN DURING MIDDLE SCHOOL

- AUTOMATICALLY ADDED TO HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT – these are the beginning of your high school GPA!
- If choose to remove, cannot be added back onto the transcript later.
- A transcript is the official document that is sent to colleges. It lists each high school level class you have taken and the final grade you received for each class.
- Your final grade in each class is calculated to formulate your GPA (grade point average).

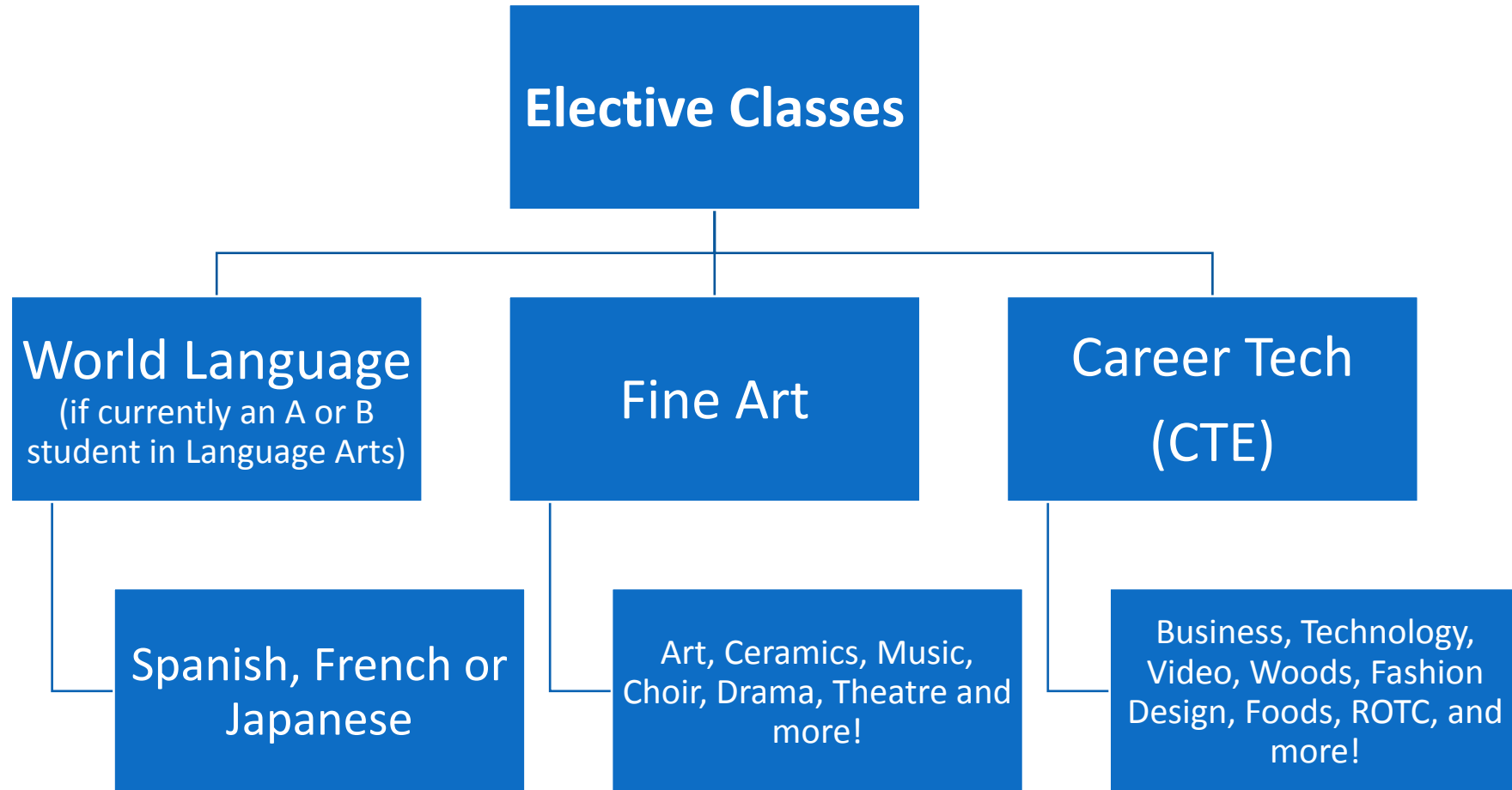

- Math Labs – Labs offered in Algebra 1, Geometry, and Algebra 2 that pair with student's Math course to provide extra support in a smaller group setting.
- ILS – ILS (Improving Literacy Skills) is offered to students in grades 9, 10, and 11. The ILS course pairs with the student's English course to provide extra support in a smaller group setting.
- Guided Study – Guided Study classes offer study and homework time during a class period in the student's schedule.
